Eva S. Schernhammer is Professor and Chair of Epidemiology at the Medical University of Vienna, Adjunct Professor at Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health, Lecturer on Medicine at Harvard Medical School, and Associate Faculty at the Complexity Science Hub Vienna. A founder of ASciNA, she has longstanding Harvard affiliations since 2003. She holds an MD (Vienna), DrPH in Epidemiology (Harvard), and MPhil in Psychology (Vienna). A pioneer of circadian epidemiology, she studies circadian disruption, biomarkers, and population health using advanced modelling. During COVID-19, she expanded into infectious disease epidemiology. She is a member of the Austrian Academy of Sciences, Academia Europaea, and the European Academy of Arts and Sciences.
